A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS

"He came to Horeb, the mountain of God. There an angel of the Lord appeared to him in fire flaming out of the bush. As he looked on, he was surprised to see that the bush, though on fire, was not consumed. So, Moses decided, 'I must go over to look at this remarkable sight and see why the bush is not burned.' When the Lord saw him coming over to look at it more closely, God called out to him from the bush, 'Moses, Moses.' He answered 'Here I am'... 'Come no nearer! Remove your sandals from your feet, for this is holy ground.'"

A new page in salvation history. Moses meets God, conversing with him in the burning bush. Wherever we are reading this, it is our Horeb. He wants us to come closer to continuing His work. As Moses was curious, so are we, as He calls us to live this Lent, by our prayer, sacrifices and good works.

He wants us to recognize His presence with us. He is asking us to come closer to Him so we can make His presence, His love and salvation known. Surely Moses didn't know what to expect but the Lord had a plan for him. He has one for us too. Why did Jesus come?

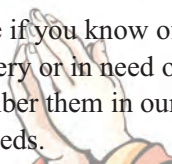


Lenten Obligation

1. The days of both **fast and abstinence** are **Ash Wednesday** (March 5) and **Good Friday** (April 18).
2. The other **Fridays of Lent** (Mar. 7, 14, 21, 28, Apr. 4 and 11) are **days of abstinence**.
3. **Fasting** in the Roman Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to **one full meal** with **two smaller meals** which together do not equal the size of your full meal. The obligation of fasting applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59.
4. **Abstinence** in the Roman Catholic tradition means to **abstain from eating meat** (beef, chicken, pork, turkey, etc.). The obligation of abstinence applies to all Catholics who have reached the age of 14.

REJOICE! RITE FOR ENTRANCE (FORMERLY KNOWN AS RITE OF ACCEPTANCE)

Next Sunday, March 30, at the 9:00 Mass, we will celebrate the Rite for Entrance for two inquirers. They have been preparing for months to take this first step toward baptism and full initiation in the Catholic Church. Following the Rite, they will be catechumens in the Order of Catechumens, having rights and privileges in the Church.

At the Rite, they will be signed with the Cross of Christ and will express acceptance of the Gospel of Jesus. May we all renew our commitment to discipleship along with them.

You, the Parish family, are very important in this Rite, for it is the entire Church that accepts inquirers as people who intend to become members. Please keep our soon-to-be catechumens in your prayers during this last week of proximate preparation for the Rite for Entrance. Over the coming year, they will prepare for baptism, confirmation, and Eucharist.

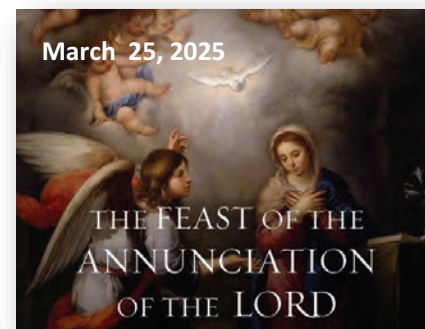
