STEWARDSHIP REFLECTIONS

"Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." LUKE 11:9

Jesus assures us that if we ask, God will take care of what we need. The problem is that our culture often confuses what we really need with what we simply want. The truth is that many of us need very little. However, we usually want so much more! Stewardship is simply being grateful for all that we are and all that we have been given, and generously sharing all of our Godgiven gifts with others. Gratitude and generosity are gifts that opens doors to new relationships with others and with God.

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this time receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You.

HIS WORD TODAY

"Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he had finished, one of the disciples said to him, 'Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples.' He said to them, 'When you pray say:...Our Father...'"

How frequently we spy Jesus alone, in a deserted place praying, in communion with His Father. The disciple asked that He teach them, already familiar with the call of John to repentance. Jesus offered what He also teaches us, a prayer of praise, of gratitude, of repentance and petition. This formula we report constantly.

There are prayers too, which go beyond words, known as mental prayer, contemplation, or a very common prayer practice taken from the scripture where a biblical passage becomes the source of meditation. Perhaps the easiest way to pray as a disciple is to remember, our prayer is our intimate conversation with the closest friend I have. I speak; I listen!

Dear Father Silva,

Please extend my sincere thanks to the parishioners of Nativity of Our Lord Parish for their generous response to the 2025 Bishop's Annual Appeal. I know that the pastor's endorsement and enthusiastic promotion of the Appeal are key in reaching the parish goal, so thanks to you, too. As of July 1, 2025, your parish achieved 128.37% of its \$88,000 goal with pledges totaling \$112,961.92 and \$104,502.66 in payments to date. I am pleased to enclose a \$8,251.33 rebate check to be used for local needs at your discretion. This check represents 50% of the amount collected over goal to date. A second round of rebate checks will be issued in November 2025 for payments received after July 1st.


