
#### **HIS WORD TODAY**

"In contrast, the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified their flesh and its passions and desires. If we live in the Spirit, let us also follow the Spirit."

The Pentecost event with wind, fire and noise are familiar signs of the coming of the Holy Spirit. There are other signs for us today to discover the presence of the Spirit in our lives in the church. They are the fruits of which Saint Paul spoke to the Galatians. In chapter 5 he enumerates nine signs, the fruits of the Spirit.


